Pocono Pre-Race Practice checklist:

- Driver approval documents emailed to Joe Wells Jwells@arcaracing.com (must be approved to practice at Pocono).
- Driver must have an approved physical, HIPAA, Assumption of Risk and Liability Waiver and drug screen on file with ARCA (dated December 1, 2021, or more recent).
- Driver must have applied and paid for a **2022** ARCA Driver license.
- Car Owner must have a **2022** ARCA Car Owner license.
- Must have a paid entry for the **2022** Pocono race event.
- Must have a paid fee for the Pre-Pocono Practice.
- Registered team owner is responsible to ensure all team documents and fees are transacted prior to going on track.
- All fees and documents must be on file with Joe Wells at the ARCA office by Friday July 15th.
- **Failure to comply will subject driver/team to dismissal from the open practice.**
- **Hauler Staging: From Interstate 80, take Highway 115 to Long Pond Road and enter track property at Gate 5. Stage behind main grandstand.**
- **All Credentialing will be conducted at the one-story Operations Building.**
- **All Team and Supplier Authorization sheets must be received by Tuesday, July 19th**

Credentials obtained for the ARCA Pocono Pre-Race Practice Thursday, July 21 will be valid through the end of the ARCA Menards Series event Friday, July 22, or rescheduled date/time if postponed.

- Garage/pit area proper attire rules for active participants apply: No shorts, no short skirts, no open-toe shoes, no bare midriff, and no sleeveless shirts. Anyone to be credentialed is to be listed on team list provided to ARCA in advance.
- Car at minimum must have legible numbers on both doors and must display ARCA bar, ARCA Menards Series, Sunoco logos; General Tire logo on the back of the spoiler, over the front tires and on front fender/nose; Menards logo on front fenders, front of the rear spoiler and windshield.
- General Tire will be on site to service team needs.
- Sunoco Unleaded 260 GTX will be available for purchase at the track.
- For ACCEL/Holley needs, contact Graham Fordyce 775-250-5740.
- Racing Electronics, Holley and Ilmor representatives will be on hand to service team needs.

ALL SAFETY EQUIPMENT MUST BE INSPECTED PRIOR TO GOING ON TRACK

ON TRACK PROCEDURES:

- All cars to be ARCA legal for on-track activity.
- Teams using any **non-compliant parts** at any time, **crew chief will be held responsible, and the car owner** will be fined at minimum \$1000 and have equipment confiscated and time disallowed.
- Obey traffic flow in the garage and on pit road.
- Stay on apron through turn 1 when entering race track.
- Limit number of consecutive laps to ten per session.
- **MUST HAVE SPOTTER IN DESIGNATED LOCATION, FUNCTIONING RACE SAFE SYSTEM AND TWO-WAY RADIO COMMUNICATION WHENEVER RACE CAR IS ON TRACK.**
- **Route to spotter stand – Tunnel under track at frontstretch S/F line to elevator.**
Remove all tape and clean garage area before leaving track.
